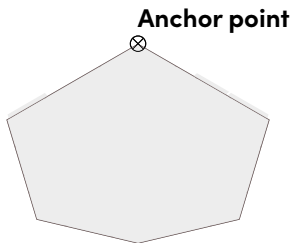
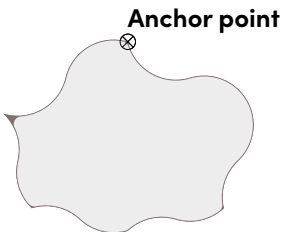




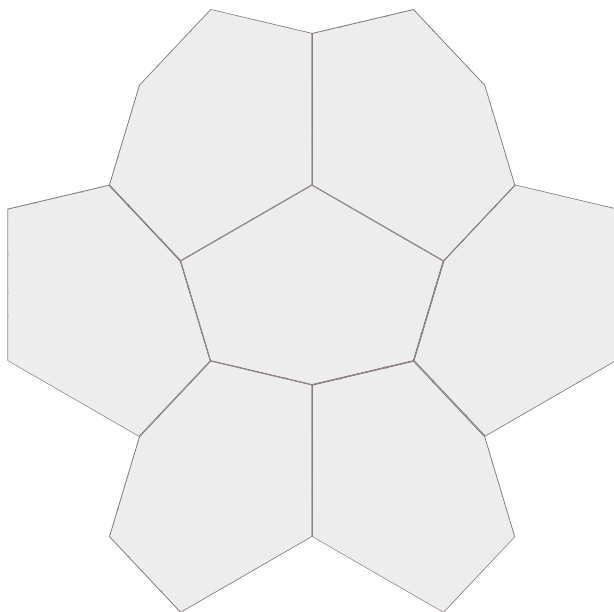
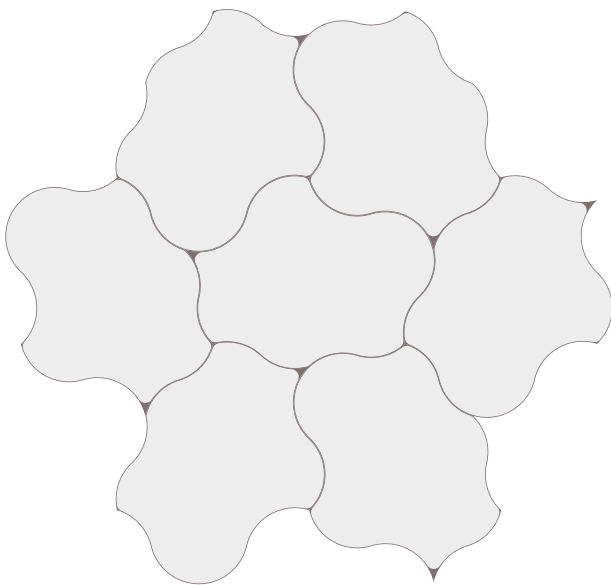
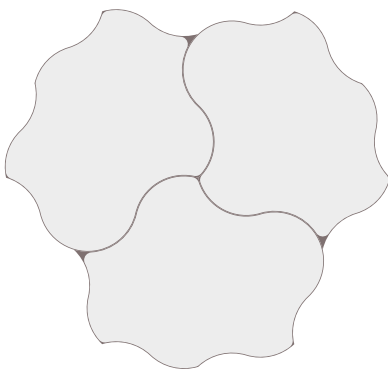
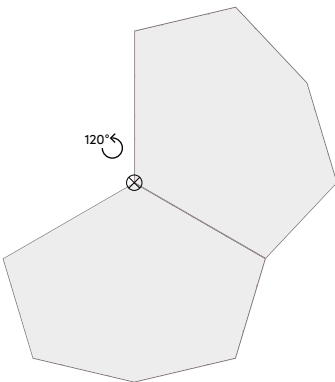
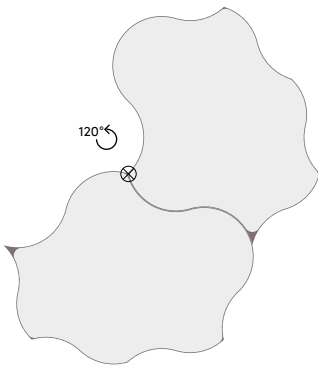
The Anchor Point

The anchor point is the reference within the digital model of the tile that determines alignment and positioning in the design. This point is located in one of the corners of the tile and serves as the basis for consistent placement in the digital environment.

Rotating the tile by 120° is essential to create an organic and aesthetically pleasing pattern. This rotation ensures that the tiles fit together perfectly and visually form a seamless structure.

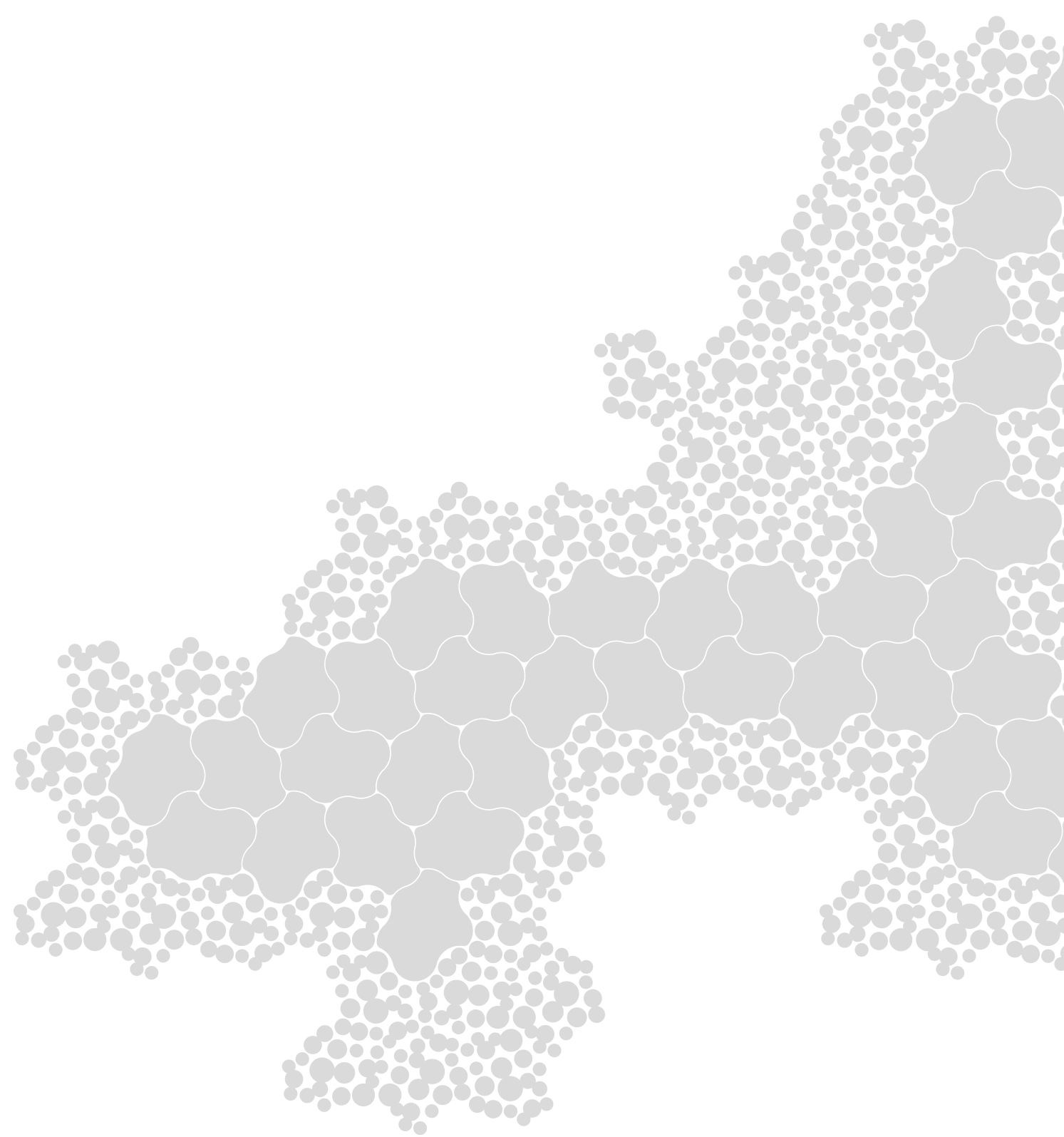
